

Instructions for use of TORNADO pepper spray with door holder

1. Product description

The TORNADO defensive pepper spray holder is designed for **easy attachment to various surfaces such as doors, walls or furniture**. It can be attached with double-sided stickers or the included screws. This holder features a **360° rotating mechanism** for quick, convenient and/or unobtrusive access to the spray.

It will be a useful tool in the event of an emergency, for example in restaurants and bars, where it can help staff increase security and respond quickly to crisis situations. It is also suitable for use in doctors' offices, post offices, banks, petrol stations and various offices where it can help protect staff and the public from unexpected security incidents.



2. Adjusting the holder

After unpacking the holder, check the adjustment of the rotation mechanism. If you are not satisfied with the rigidity of the rotation or you want to fix the holder in one position, adjust the fixation with the cross screw available on the back of the holder base. Adjust the rotation stiffness **before gluing** it in place, as it will not be possible to adjust the mechanism after gluing.

3. Mounting the holder

The holder base is divided into 2 parts. For gluing with a double-sided sticker, it is recommended to leave both parts whole for better adhesion of the sticker to a larger area. For screwing, you can break off the bottom part of the base.

You can attach the holder base in the following ways:

- **Double-sided sticker (recommended for smooth surfaces)**
 - Suitable for wood, glass, metal and other flat and smooth surfaces.
 - We do not recommend bonding to the plaster as it could be damaged or torn off during de-installation.
 - Before gluing, the surface must be degreased and treated for better adhesion, preferably with alcohol.
- **Included screws (recommended for stronger fixing)**
 - Designed for wood and plastic surfaces.
 - Use the indicated holes on the sides of the base, which must be pierced with a screw.



- **Installation in masonry**

- **Fixing to different types of masonry:** In this case, you must provide dowels with screws that match the type of masonry, e.g. solid brick, hollow brick, concrete, aerated concrete or plasterboard.

4. Storage of defensive spray

- It is recommended to keep the spray in an upright position.
- If mounted under the table top, the spray can be placed horizontally.
- **Mount the defensive spray and keep it out of the reach of children!**
- Make sure that the spray head fits correctly on the holder – see picture on the right.



5. Removing the holder base

Caution! Before any attempt is made to remove (peel off) the base adhered with double-sided tape from the wall or other object, **remove the spray from the holder**. It is recommended to heat the base adequately with a hair dryer or heat gun and then carefully try to peel or cut it off with the blade of a snap-off knife so as not to damage the original substrate.

6. Basic safety instructions for pepper spray

- The spray is intended for self-defense only and should only be used in a threatening situation.
- Do not expose the spray to high temperatures above 50 °C or direct sunlight.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not expose the spray to mechanical shocks – damage to the packaging and unwanted gas leakage could occur.
- If the eyes or mucous membranes are affected, rinse the affected area with a stream of cold water for at least 15 minutes. If the discomfort persists after 1 hour, see a doctor immediately.
- **Further safety instructions are given on the packaging of TORNADO spray.**
